Digital Inclusion and Support for the West End Community



With funding support from West End Morecambe (WEM), Lancaster & Morecambe College (LMC) has launched a new Digital Inclusion project in the West End, offering advice, support and training for local residents to help them develop essential digital skills.

Through a series of drop-in workshops and 1-1 sessions, adults will be able to build confidence and develop key skills in a supportive environment, allowing them to progress onto recognised qualifications.

John Goodrich, who previously managed the Morecambe Learning Centre, will be offering a range of workshops and classes at The Link on West Street, which opened in summer 2024 and is a collaborative venture between Lancaster & Morecambe College, Lancaster District CVS, Morecambe Bay Poverty Truth and Stanleys Community Centre.

Charlotte Rawes, LMC's Vice Principal Progress & Performance, was pleased that the College was able to provide this much-needed support to local residents.

"This project will enable Lancaster & Morecambe College to have a visible presence in the West End of Morecambe, providing support, advice & guidance to the wider community. Digital Inclusion is essential for everyday life and this will help remove barriers for residents who are unable to access this support outside of their local area. It will also help individuals to develop confidence, knowledge and build key skills, supporting them to progress into employment or further training, or to simply communicate more effectively with family and friends."

Funding for the Digital Inclusion project coincided with plans for the opening of The Link on West Street, a collaboration which was borne out of the second round of the Morecambe Bay Poverty Truth Commission.

The idea was for the different agencies to work together out of one centre, offering a range of support, advice and

learning opportunities to residents of the West End, and this came to fruition last year when The Link opened its doors for the first time. Guests and visitors were able to drop-in to visit the centre, enjoy a cuppa and a cake, and chat with the team behind the partnership.

So, who are the partners and how will the local community benefit from this new venture?

Lancaster District CVS work to improve communities by bringing people together and supporting voluntary, community, faith, and social enterprise sector organisations. They will use the space to meet with individuals and businesses across the local community.

Lancaster & Morecambe College will be offering 1-1 support to adults who want to develop their knowledge and skills; there will be informal drop-in sessions available, alongside funded Digital and IT qualifications. As part of the College's new Positive Prospects project, they will also work with young people who are risk of NEET (not in education, employment or training) to support them to re-engage with learning and build confidence.

The Link will offer free Wi-Fi to anyone visiting the centre and MBPTC will use it as a headquarters for community commissioner recruitment and engagement.

Beccy Wheildon

Course taken: Access to HE Diploma

Profession: Pursuing a career in nursing

Beccy left school with her heart set on working in finance but later decided she wanted to change her career path and become a nurse in her late 30s. Originally, this didn't seem possible to Beccy as she didn't have the qualifications needed.

I left school knowing I wanted to go into finance, and worked for Skipton Building Society where I progressed to becoming the branch manager. At aged 36, I had an idea of becoming a nurse, but put it aside thinking it wasn't possible. After talking to people, I realised it was achievable by doing the Access course at College.

Living between Lancaster and Kendal gave Beccy options for studying the Access to HE course. The Access course at LMC allows you to progress onto a degree course in a field related to the course topics including: nursing, teaching, social work and sciences.

I came to an open day at LMC, everyone was really friendly and I was impressed with the professionalism of the College and Laura, the tutor. She was amazing!

The Access course provides you with the skills and knowledge you will need to progress further to university. Beccy says that she has enjoyed returning to learning and is looking forward to progressing to university after the Access course, and says,

The best bits about the course have been the learning, specifically the Human Physiology has been really interesting.

I was out of education for 24 years and it was just so daunting the idea of studying again. The course is challenging but manageable if you commit to it. Don't be scared to give it a go, you won't regret it!

Free Courses For Jobs

Adults aged 19+ can access a FREE Level 3 course with support available from the Government, helping you gain skills that employers value, improve your job prospects and earn a good wage whatever your stage in life.

Eligibility

- You are over the age of 19 and earning under £25,000
- You are over the age of 19 and unemployed
- You are aged 19 - 23 and earning over £25,000 and don't already hold a full Level 3 qualification

Course Funding & Finance

Many of our learners study for FREE!

Don't be put off by the cost of studying, many of our learners study for free. Eligibility depends on your individual circumstances and the course you have chosen to study.

You may also be able to access the Learner Support Fund for financial support for some of the additional costs when studying, whether that is travel costs, equipment or uniform for your course or childcare costs.

You may also be eligible for FREE study if you are unemployed and receive an eligible benefit and you are taking the course to help you find employment. You may be eligible for a subsidised rate of £25 per course if you are employed and in receipt of certain benefits – look for courses marked with ♦ throughout this course guide.

Can I study for free?

If you are studying a legal entitlement course such as English, Maths or Essential Digital Skills - Entry Level, Level 1, or Level 2, or are unemployed, or earn less than £25,000 gross salary, then the answer is YES! When you enrol, you will need to provide evidence of your salary or benefits.

If you have achieved the qualification to be studied previously, or have an existing qualification at a higher level, then fees will apply.

What if I need to take out a loan?

Advanced Learner Loans are also available for eligible courses and available to anyone over the age of 19, regardless of individual circumstances, studying Level 3 or Level 4 courses. The loan will fully cover your fees and will only need to be repaid when you earn over a certain threshold and subject to the payment plan assigned. More information is provided on application for the Advanced Learner Loan.

What if I need to pay for the course?

If the course is available for online enrolment, you can pay online as part of the enrolment process. You can also pay by cash or card in the Hex or by phoning our Finance team on 01524 521205.

Will I be entitled to any financial help while studying at College?

You may be entitled to financial support while you are studying, through the College's Learner Support Fund. Help is available with transport, uniform and kit costs and childcare. It is easy to apply via our Pay My Student digital portal.

Having left school without achieving any of my GCSEs and being informed that I had severe dyslexia, I decided to apply to study various Adult Education courses at college whilst working a number of part-time jobs. At that time, I didn't really have a career path in mind, but knew that if I gained my GCSEs this would be a good starting point.

College was very different to school, studying alongside other adults suited my style of learning. The tutors were more aware of my learning needs and were very supportive. I also utilised the learning support that was offered to me by attending group workshops and 1:1 sessions, where I was provided with tips and guidance on how to improve my work.

After successfully gaining my GCSEs, I progressed onto a Level 3 qualification, and from that point on there was no stopping me. I eventually decided to go into teaching as I wanted to help others with learning difficulties to have the opportunity to achieve.

Courses taken: GCSE English & Maths, Access to HE Diploma

Profession: Pursuing a career in nursing

Bernie decided to return to education at age 40 to pursue his dream career in nursing. After taking advice from the Careers team at LMC, he began studying GCSE English & maths alongside the Access to HE Diploma.

Due to my age, I never thought I would be able to do GCSEs again. My tutors were absolutely amazing, they were so patient and gave me the help and encouragement I needed to believe in myself.

At LMC, we have dedicated learning support and pastoral teams to help your College experience be the best it can be as Bernie explains,

I suffer with anxiety so the learning support team has been a great help, allowing me to sit in a quieter room with only a few students during my exams. In a large hall like back at school, I would have felt too overwhelmed.

Achieving his English GCSE and studying the Access to HE course has further supported Bernie on his journey into his nursing career.

Studying for GCSE English has refined my communication skills, which will benefit me as an adult nurse. Strong communication skills are the bedrock of effective patient advocacy and will enable me to comprehend and address the unique needs of individuals in my care. The Access to HE course has provided me with a theoretical foundation to complement my practical experiences, laying a groundwork for my transition into undergraduate study.

When asked what advice he would give to students thinking of returning to education at a later age, Bernie said:

Believe in yourself no matter what your background or age, the College is amazing at helping everyone.

Courses taken: Distance Learning, GCSE Maths, GCSE Biology, Access To HE

Profession: Pursuing a career in midwifery

Tanya was initially introduced to learning at LMC through our Distance Learning courses. These are free online courses allowing you to fit your learning around other commitments such as your work and home life.

Choosing to study at LMC was the best choice for me, especially as a single mum. I am aiming to study midwifery, and I would not be able to do that without completing the distance learning courses first.

Tanya then completed GCSEs in Maths & Biology, before enrolling onto the Access to HE course in September 2024.

The courses have provided Tanya with the knowledge she needs to continue her studies, and she then plans to apply to study midwifery at University.

I love that I have gained all this knowledge as I know it is going to help me with my future career. I have met some wonderful people along the way at LMC, from staff to my fellow students.

As well as gaining the technical knowledge required to pass the exams, Tanya has also gained soft skills such as time management and communication.

Time management has always been something I struggled with and through these courses I have been able to improve this skill. I have also learnt how to effectively work within a group and adapt to a busy environment.

My advice to anyone thinking of studying any of the Distance Learning courses or GCSE courses, would be to definitely give it a try! No matter what your situation, the staff at College are always there to help.



Maths/English & Digital Skills

**Don't have your Maths, English or Digital qualifications?
Don't let that hold you back...**

We offer FREE Maths, English and Digital workshops on the main College campus, at The Link at West Street and out in the community at venues such as Morecambe Library, Brew Me Sunshine in Morecambe and Cornerstones in Lancaster. Join our workshops to achieve new skills in order for you to be able to progress in work, life or to university. The classes are timetabled to fit around family and work commitments. Functional workshops are also available where we offer Functional Maths and Functional English from Entry 1 – Level 2.

The Essential Digital Skills course is intended to support the development of digital skills required for everyday life, work and further study and includes internet safety/cyber security. It provides a nationally recognised digital skills qualification and is a step towards further study. We offer Essential Digital Skills at Entry 3 and Level 1 alongside Level 2 Digital and IT Skills Award, which give you the opportunity to develop your Word and Excel skills.

Apprenticeships

Apprenticeships are the perfect opportunity for those who want to broaden their industry knowledge, skills and behaviours while earning a salary and building professional connections. They are available to anyone over 16 and offer fantastic opportunities for upskilling to adults already within an industry, or who wish to retrain in a different sector.



Nahim Rashid

Courses taken: Team Leading Level 3 Apprenticeship

Profession: Senior Housing Officer at Calico Homes

Nahim had worked in the care sector for more than 5 years before he started his Team Leading Level 3 Apprenticeship. Initially, as an adult learner, he was hesitant as to how an apprenticeship would impact on his working life, but he is glad he completed the course as he has been able to develop in his role and gain a greater understanding of being a manager and a leader.

I chose an Apprenticeship to learn and develop, both personally and professionally. I am really glad that I did as it has helped me to progress on my career path.

As an apprentice, Nahim attended College twice a month and also had 1-1 meetings with his assessor. He also took part in both English & Maths Functional Skills classes alongside his Apprenticeship, to ensure that he was up to date with the qualifications he needed to pass the end point assessment of his Apprenticeship.

The Apprenticeship enabled me to continue working whilst I was learning and I was able to put into practice my learning in "real time".

Nahim said he gained lots of skills whilst undertaking his Apprenticeship, including time management techniques, more confidence and belief in himself that he didn't have after stepping back into education after 20 years.

I would recommend an Apprenticeship 100%, as it allows you to gain a qualification, but, more importantly, it allows you to gain knowledge that can be applied within your role and your sector.

The next steps for Nahim is to look at a Management & Leadership (Level 5) CMI qualification, to further advance his skill set and then go into self-employment within the care sector, specifically focusing on supported housing.

MYTH 1: Apprenticeships are only for school leavers

REALITY: Apprenticeships are open to individuals of all ages. Whether you are 16 or 60, there are no age restrictions when it comes to pursuing an apprenticeship. The opportunities that apprenticeships offer are available to anyone willing to invest in their personal and professional development, regardless of their age.

MYTH 2: Apprenticeships are for people who aren't academic

REALITY: This is not true. Apprenticeships are an alternative route into employment and those choosing this route are ambitious and keen to earn while they learn. Many simply prefer the hands-on experience that an apprenticeship can bring.

MYTH 3: I won't be able to afford it/I won't be paid

REALITY: Apprentices are paid, and often more than you might think! These are genuine jobs with accompanying skills development programmes. They give people the chance to bring home a salary while they learn and build a platform for their career.

MYTH 4: Apprenticeships are only available in certain sectors

REALITY: The days when apprenticeships were available only in certain industries like construction and manufacturing are long gone. They're now available in a huge range of sectors, like finance, hospitality, education, business and management.

MYTH 5: An apprenticeship will limit my future career prospects

REALITY: Apprenticeships can take you right to the top of an organisation. Employers increasingly value apprenticeships as a viable career route. It means applicants have real experience of the workplace and, at the end, often a qualification too. Most employers look at someone's experience and their qualifications - an apprenticeship delivers both.

MYTH 6: If I do an apprenticeship, I'll get stuck in one job

REALITY: Apprenticeships are available in a variety of industries and equip you with the transferable skills that employers from many different sectors will value. Some apprenticeships offer the opportunity to work in different parts of a business too, which allows you to experience various roles and find what you enjoy doing. An apprenticeship is a foot in the door and can open up many exciting new career paths.

MYTH 8: I'll be making tea all the time

REALITY: Apprenticeships provide valuable work experience and training in a real job environment. While there may be occasional tasks like making tea for colleagues, apprentices are integral team members with real responsibilities. Employers invest in apprentices by providing them with meaningful work that contributes to the organisation, helping them develop essential skills and knowledge for future career growth.



Profession: Regional Director, Westmorland Homecare

Danny Stackhouse

Danny left high school and started an Electrical Installation Level 2 course here at LMC. Quickly realising this wasn't the route for him, he started working in a local care home. Here he found a passion for care and nursing and decided that was the career route for him, so set off on his path to progress onto university. Danny didn't have his Maths GCSE, which is a strict requirement for any university course in the nursing field, so he came back to LMC part time to complete that.

Once he had passed his Maths GCSE, he spoke to the tutors at College about how best to achieve his dreams of becoming a nurse, and mapped out his path to ensure he gained a place at university. This started with Health & Social Care Level 2 in 2021, so that he could progress onto the Access to HE course in 2022. The Access to HE Diploma is specifically designed for people aged 19 and over who want to progress onto university.

I learnt so much on the Access course, especially in subjects that I had never come across before such as Psychology and Social Issues in health care.

Danny was able to continue working while studying and found he could apply what he learnt at College into his daily responsibilities.

When asked what the best bits of his course were, Danny said,

The Access to HE course helped me develop my skillset, particularly in time keeping, communication, team work and problem solving; all useful skills which I will carry with me into my degree course at university.

When asked what advice he would give to someone who was thinking about taking the Access course, Danny said,

100% do it! The staff are so supportive and you meet people with common career interests too.

How many days will I be in College?

Most of our part time courses are one evening a week, or one half day a week. The Access courses are classed as full time courses and are over three days a week but your tutor will share the timetable with you at interview.
